



### 1. Download App

Download the Google Cardboard app on your smartphone. Open the App and at the bottom right, tap the camera icon.

### 2. Move Your Device

With your arms outstretched, move your device slowly in a circle to the left or right.

### 3. Finish 360° Turn

The camera stops recording automatically once you complete a full 360° turn. To finish before then, tap done.

### 4. Retouch

You can retouch and edit your 360° photo with applications like Adobe Photoshop.

### 5. Post

Once complete, you can post your 360° photo on Facebook, Google Photos, Flickr VR, Kuula, Roundme, 360player.io, Momento360, etc.

### 6. Try It

If you have access to a VR headset you can test your 360° VR photo.
